



IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read this leaflet BEFORE using Ewetopia Indoor Playground

All rules are displayed at the entrance of Ewetopia; these must be strictly adhered to for everyone's safety. It is vital that you explain these safety rules to your children before they use the equipment so that they can have the maximum fun at minimum risk.

Adults must **NOT** leave children of any age unsupervised. We strongly advise that small children are accompanied down the slides with their parent/guardian or supervisor.

When using the slides it is advisable to wear long sleeve tops and socks as skin contact with the slide can cause friction burns.

- MATS must be used on the blue waterfall slide but not on any other slide
- Always go down slides feet first on your back
- Visitors with long hair should take care when using the spiders web
- No smoking or alcohol is allowed within Ewetopia
- No "IT" or "TAG" games
- Do not use the slides until the bottoms of the slide are completely clear of others
- Physical or verbal abuse to the staff will not be tolerated
- Children and ADULTS must obey the safety staff at all times
- Caution: Nylon clothing may burn on the slides
- Trampolines: 1 person per trampoline at any time

No picnics may be consumed within Ewetopia due to the risk of broken glass, china or cans. Similarly, china and glass from the main restaurant may not be brought into Ewetopia. Picnic areas are provided opposite the Duck Trialling arena, over the stream or by the Brewery. Those with special dietary needs, who bring their own food, must consult the Ewetopia Staff and they will be provided with an area to consume their food. We are vigilant about this, people who break this rule will be asked to leave.

We use a strobe light as part of our lighting effects, for medical reasons this can be turned off at the request of visitors.

We use CCTV to monitor Ewetopia and other areas for safety and security reasons.

We request that parents and supervisors do not let children open the fire exit doors as these are alarmed for safety. Anyone who persists in opening these doors may be asked to leave.

We provide specific play areas for under 5's and under 2's and their supervisors; the rest of the playground is suitable for any age group.

The Internet Café is located next to the under 2's play area; children must be supervised by their parents/guardians at all times. This area is not part of the playground and should not be used for running around etc. No food or drink may be brought into or consumed within the Internet Café. Our computers are net protected against inappropriate sites, anyone found mistreating and misusing the equipment may be permanently banned. All damage caused will immediately be chargeable to the individual(s)

At all times, children are the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian or supervisor.

Visitors who break the rules may be asked to leave and be banned from the playground and/or the whole site
In such cases, NO refund will be given
